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Who was targeted?	Reading Recovery – year 1 pupils BRWP – F2,Y1,Y2.Y3,Y4,Y5
Outline of project:	
<p>Reading Recovery – an intensive, 1:1, short term, reading programme designed for children aged 5yrs and 6yrs of age, delivered by a trained teacher</p> <p>BRWP- a short term, 1:1, reading programme, delivered by a trained teaching assistant, supported and monitored by a Reading Recovery teacher</p>	
Overview of the timelines, additional resources etc.	
<p>Reading Recovery training takes place over an academic year with 6 sessions of CPD every subsequent year. Teachers become highly skilled at diagnosing and supporting pupils, with a diverse range of reading and writing difficulties. Reading Recovery teachers are able to provide advice and support to colleagues across the school. Boosting Reading and Writing Progress involves 3½ days of training for teaching assistants, followed by regular observations and support from Reading Recovery teacher.</p> <p>Resources:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a quiet place to work with individual pupils • finely levelled books – PM books specifically support Reading Recovery and other schemes can be levelled 	
Impact	
<p>8 out of 10 Reading Recovery pupils learnt 4 times faster than their class mates. Evidence shows that these children maintain the gains made and achieve average to good scores in national testing</p> <p>BRWP pupils make on average, 13 months gain in a 14 week programme</p>	
Lessons learnt – advice for other schools	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • careful assessment of pupils ensures they embark on the programme at the optimum time • close working with the class teacher is essential • pupils who have support at home make faster progress 	
Estimate of costs	<p>For LA schools, Reading Recovery initial training costs £1350 and CPD costs £585 per year. Academies will pay 20% more.</p> <p>BRWP training can be arranged free of charge through WIT or can be carried out in a host school for TAs from a variety of schools, for £450.</p>
